
The Bowerbird by Julia Donaldson




We're following a rainbow to find the Rainbowsaurus.


KEY STAGE 1

Suddenly their icy homeland doesn't seem so dull .





Jack, the worst diver, in the worst diving team in Damp Bottom, sees his luck change when a new pupil with magical abilities joins the school. But trouble soon strikes and when the fate of the entire world is at stake, Jack's team discovers helping your friends is more important than winning. It's a good story to encourage teamwork, working together and resilience.

The island of Ramoa was once luscious and populated with mighty beasts. Now though, it is home to barren and tamed cities. where nature is locked out and trouble is brewing. When Kayla's beloved animal companion, a rare winged pangron, is stolen. she's determined to get him back.
